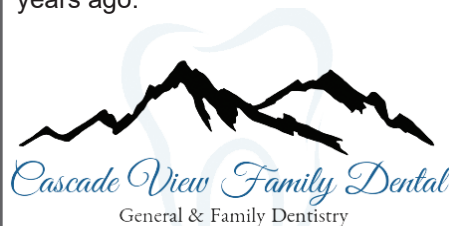

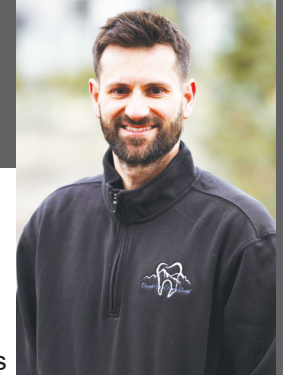

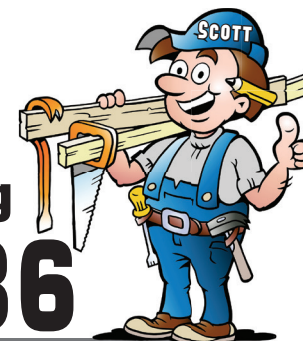

Summer Vacation Let's Go!

In the summer of 1989, at the age of 10, I broke my elbow during a rousing game of street hockey. It was Neil's fault. He was my 11-year-old, olive-skinned gorgeous neighbor who took me out at the ankles with a sneaky cross-check. We visited the Grand Canyon and reluctantly abandoned the beast in a parking lot to enjoy an hour-long wagon ride. Back aboard our movable home, we made meals and showered and read *The Adventures of Tom Sawyer* by candlelight. It was an idyllic picture of a 1980s family vacation, until.....

"Mom, is there supposed to be this much water on the floor?"

On the fifth day of our trip, we learned about "gray water." A gray-water tank holds refuse from the shower or sink-water with bits of old food and dirt in it. As neophyte campers, we had no idea that not disposing of this water regularly leads to it backing up and flooding your entire living space. We luckily found a campground and checked in.

While my sisters and I tried to stow our belongings on high

ground in the RV, my parents were sloshing through water, trying to pump the tank and not get divorced at the same time.

Despite our soggy state, the next day we forged onward to the next destination. We arrived just as the sun was setting, and Dad wanted to drive us by some well-known structure to see it all lit up in all its glory. As we drove past, oohing and ahing, something else went wrong. Every time Dad took his foot off the gas, the RV's head and taillights would go out. We had to keep the speedometer at about 12 mph just to keep the lights on. After countless loops around the block, we took a sharp right and coasted into a parking lot a few blocks away, where our damp and dark home on wheels sputtered to a stop.

The next day, as we stepped out into the daylight, there was a lot of people gathered in the parking lot. We wandered over and realized that the governor-elect was having a meet-n-greet. We probably smelled a little musty, but we still stood in line to meet and chat with him. I told him that I hoped to one day be the first female President. I can't remember how he responded, but I like to think he'd definitely vote for me - the smelly little girl with high ambition.

It wasn't a luxurious vacation, but it was certainly a memorable one. And it was our one and only in a home on wheels!
