#### • DINNER ROLL (unbuttered)

RANGE: 15-20 yards

PRECISION REQUIRED: high, recommend body shot **DAMAGE DONE:** slight (increases if buttered) PLUSES: fast deployment, concealable, does not necessarily spark retaliation, deniability is high, dipping roll in another dish allows for enhanced attack

MINUSES: not the most satisfying "weapon"

#### STUFFING

RANGE: 8-10 yards - if formed into a all PRECISION REQUIRED: medium (high if in a ball) DAMAGE DONE: light to moderate PLUSES: usually a large store of ammo, in a ball it's pretty solid, retaliation is minimal (unless it contains oysters or giblets) MINUSES: too dry to damage clothing, you are wasting one of the best foods of the meal

MINUSES: hard to make it look like an accident
