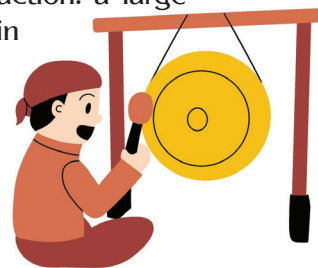

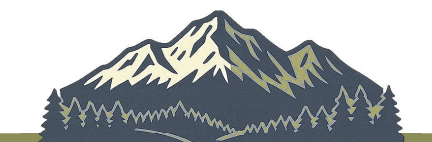

Thanksgiving Food Fight

One of our favorite traditions is the good 'ole family Thanksgiving Food Fight. It's been a "thing" since Uncle Thomas tossed the fruit salad at Aunt Margo back in '83 (I was 8).....looking back, it probably wasn't in "fun", but we look forward to it every year. Over the years I've put together an "attack guide" of our holiday foods as to be the most prepared in the fight! Each food has been carefully studied and I stand firm in these findings! Figured I'd pass it along in case y'all wanted to start your own fun this year! Oh, ya, it's funnest when you start as soon as the food gets to the table - increases the "damage" factor!!!

• DINNER ROLL (unbuttered)

RANGE: 15-20 yards

PRECISION REQUIRED: high, recommend body shot

DAMAGE DONE: slight (increases if buttered)

PLUSES: fast deployment, concealable, does not necessarily spark retaliation, deniability is high, dipping roll in another dish allows for enhanced attack

MINUSES: not the most satisfying "weapon"

• STUFFING

RANGE: 8-10 yards - if formed into a ball

PRECISION REQUIRED: medium (high if in a ball)

DAMAGE DONE: light to moderate

PLUSES: usually a large store of ammo, in a ball it's pretty solid, retaliation is minimal (unless it contains oysters or giblets)

MINUSES: too dry to damage clothing, you are wasting one of the best foods of the meal

• MASHED POTATOES

RANGE: approximately 5 yards

PRECISION REQUIRED: medium to low

DAMAGE DONE: slight (increases if buttered)

PLUSES: good splatter effect, can be thrown or rubbed in victims face

MINUSES: if deployed immediately upon serving it may result in scalding which invites retaliation

• APPLE CIDER/CHAMPAGNE

RANGE: 5-6 yards

PRECISION REQUIRED: high

DAMAGE DONE: if uncorked, moderate to high - if corked, extensive

PLUSES: stickiness results in long-lasting damage

MINUSES: may cause hospital visit if corked

• GREEN BEAN CASSEROLE

RANGE: approximately 5 yards

PRECISION REQUIRED: low (high splatter factor)

DAMAGE DONE: moderate to high

PLUSES: good splatter effect, can be thrown or rubbed in victims face

MINUSES: may result in scalding, invites retaliation

• CRANBERRY SAUCE

RANGE: can shape, 5 yards - mushed up, 1 yard

PRECISION REQUIRED: can shape, moderate

to high - mushed up, low

DAMAGE DONE: can shape, slight splattering - mushed up, incredible splattering

PLUSES: as long as you make contact, you'll never be a food fight loser

MINUSES: hard to make it look like an accident

• GRAVY

RANGE: 0-3 yards

PRECISION REQUIRED: throwing, high - dumping, low

DAMAGE DONE: high

PLUSES: very gross, could contain turkey skin

MINUSES: chunks of meat could cause eye damage, if mom makes a dry turkey then everyone suffers, most always sparks retaliation



• GIBLETS

RANGE: out of bag, 1 yard - in bag, 15 yards

PRECISION REQUIRED: low unless in bag then high

DAMAGE DONE: high (due to stink & stickiness)

PLUSES: utterly vile, may cause victim to vomit

MINUSES: they stink, if in bag may be thrown back

• TURKEY

RANGE: 1-12 yards

PRECISION REQUIRED: high

DAMAGE DONE: total

PLUSES: devastating attack - the ultimate weapon

MINUSES: after attack all turkey fragments could be used as weapons against you, hearing for the next 10 years how you ruined the meal

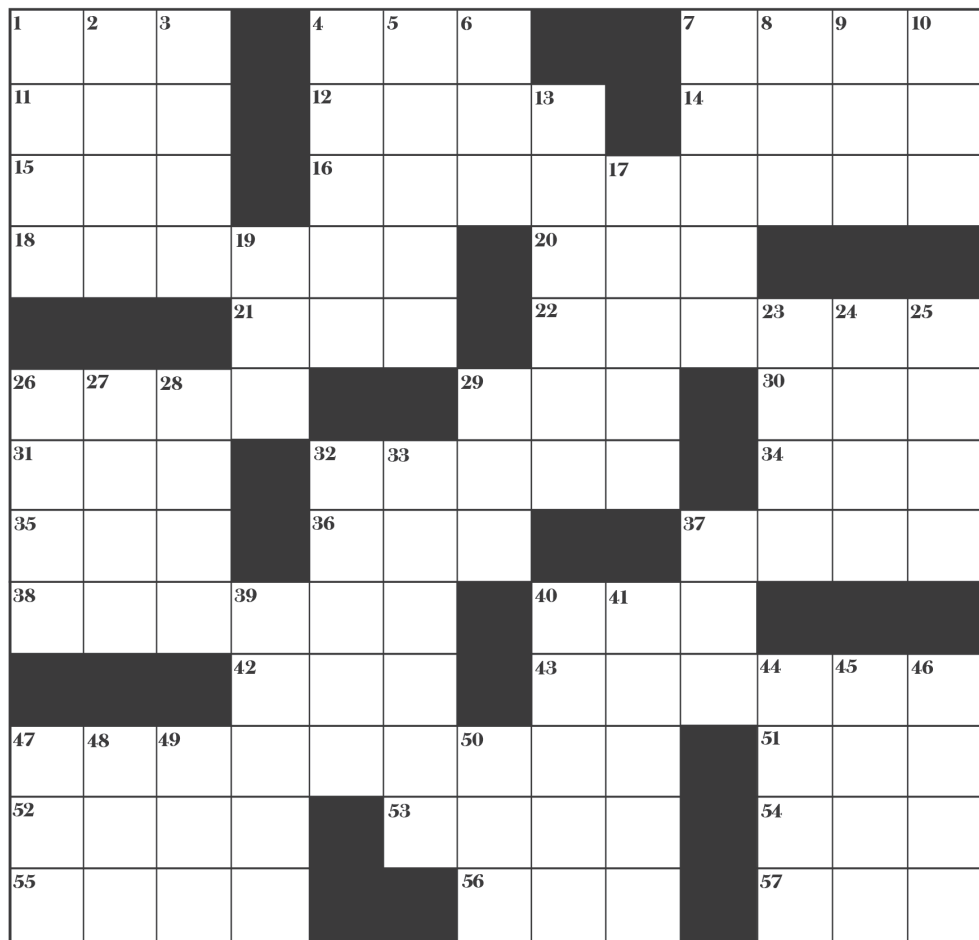
