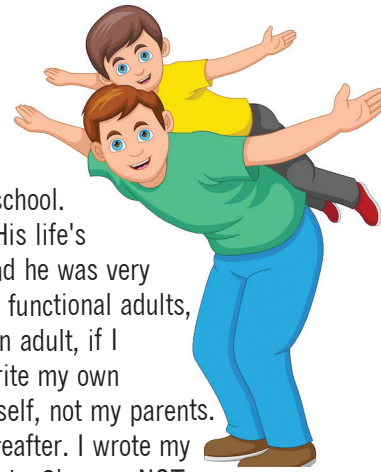

My dad used to go to bed quite early and was always up

by 4 am. One summer night when we were teenagers, my brother stayed out very late with his friends and came home slightly inebriated around 4:30 am. My dad was up and drinking his coffee at the picnic table outside. My brother was trying to fit his key into the lock to get into the house, while swaying just a bit. My dad said very loudly, "Need some help with that?" Nearly scared the pants off my brother. I'm just glad it was him and not me! ~ Carrie

I turned 18 when I was a senior in high school. My dad was one of the school counselors. His life's work was ushering teens into adulthood, and he was very big on helping his own daughters grow into functional adults, too. A few months later, I got some kind of virus that made me super sick and I missed an entire week of school. On the morning I was going back, I begged my dad to write an excuse for me because the last time I'd written my own had been such an ordeal. At first, my dad refused, but finally he said, "Oh...okay, I'll do it if it means that much to you." So he scribbled a note on a piece of paper, folded it and handed it to me.

At the attendance office, I handed over the note. The attendance lady opened it, read the note, looked at me, and said, "Do you think this is funny?" I had no idea what she was talking about. She handed me the note. My dad had signed it George Washington! ~ Lara



My dad had a creative and funny way of maintaining the rules in our house. When I was a teenager, we lived in a split-level house where the stairs to the bedroom hallway were directly opposite the living room sofa. Sometimes I would have a girlfriend over, and we'd be sitting on the couch talking after my parents were in bed. Just when we would start thinking about making out, my dad would suddenly appear, walking down the hall from his bedroom to the bathroom in nothing but his tighty whities. He'd smile, wave and instantly kill the mood. No one feels romantic after a sight like that! ~ Frank
