



Jan 28 - Starting Your Genealogy Journey: Tools, Tips & Community Resources



ing carnivore has a knack for showing up only when it feels like it, which is not often. Join Deschutes Land and Trust and Jamie Bowels, Regional Habitat Biologist with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife and unofficial "fox whisperer", for a lively dive into what we're learning about these high-elevation Houdinis. Jamie will share new finding on where the foxes roam, what habitats they actually prefer vs the ones they let us find, and why studying them often involves snow, patience and the occasional sense of humor. Attendees will leave with a clearer picture of the fox's status in the Central Cascades, a few behind-the-scenes field stories and a renewed appreciation for one of Oregon's most charming and stealthy animals.

Lynn Arnett


March 25, 1944 - December 26, 2025

Be Mindful, Be Kind, Be Smart


