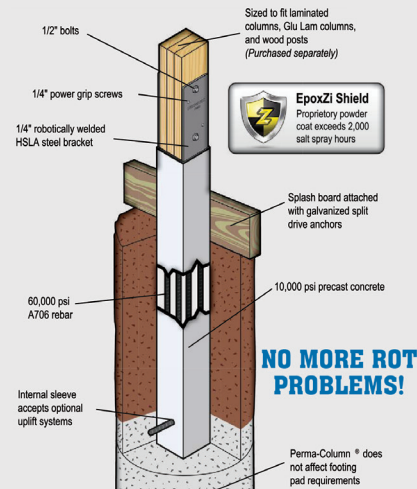

Lynda Lea Landis-Jones October 1, 1961 - March 23, 2024

Lynda Lea Landis-Jones passed away on March 23, 2024 at her home in Honolulu, Hawaii. She was 62 years old. Lynda was born in Dover, Ohio on October 1, 1961 to parents Loren and Carrol Landis. The family moved to Oregon in 1963. She grew up in the Prineville/Post area and attended elementary through high school in Prineville. Lynda visited brother Steve, a Marine stationed in Honolulu, Hawaii in 1979, and ended up staying.

She worked many different jobs throughout her life but her most loved occupation was in the music industry. She met her husband in Honolulu where they had a country western band called Rio, in which Lynda played bass guitar, drums and sang. They traveled back to the mainland to visit and lived for short periods in the states of Oregon, California, Texas, Virginia and Maryland before eventually moving back to Honolulu. Throughout the years they continued to maintain the country music band Rio, and at one time played at various venues in Central Oregon along with her brother Clint Landis. Lynda and her husband ultimately parted ways but she established her own band, Black Gold, and continued to play music for some years in Honolulu.

Lynda also had a talent for writing and shared many of her poems/verses and short stories with her family and friends. She was a staunch supporter of the Marine Corps, brought about because of her brother Steve's enlistment in that branch of the service. Merle Haggard was her most loved country music artist. She loved animals and her last pets, 2 cats and a dog, were all adopted from animal shelters. After years of claiming to be agnostic, Lynda professed to being a believer in Christianity and thanked Jesus many times for helping her through these last several years. Lynda was very much loved by all her family and friends and will be greatly missed.

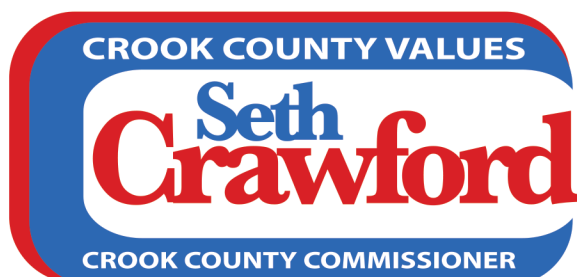

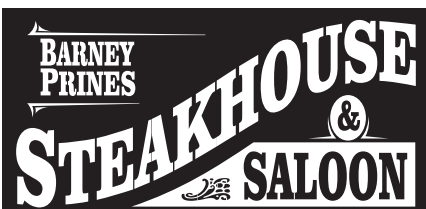

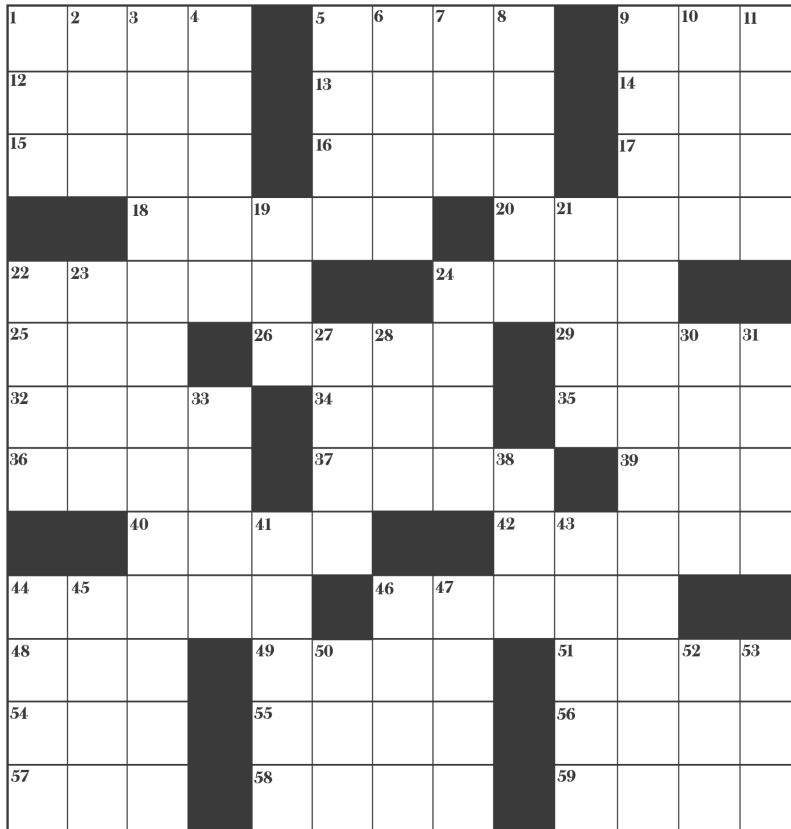
